## Dear Parent

To help your child enjoy the Summer Camp we wish to inform you of the following:

The day's activities begin at 9.30am and finish at 3.30pm at which time your child should be collected. Group 1 (Mini Players) may be collected earlier by prior arrangement with the Camp Manager.

Registration will take place on the first morning of the camp. Failure to register on the first morning of the camp (unless you have made prior arrangements with our camp office) may result in the forfeiture of your place. The balance of the fee must be paid at this stage. Each child will be allocated to a group for the week. We endeavour to make sure that parents are not detained for longer than fifteen minutes.

Children are grouped according to their age. This is by far the most practical method when one has to organise a range of creative and physical activities. Children often ask to be in the same group as their brother/sister/friend. There is no problem with this provided they are roughly the same age. As some of the activities on our programme are physically challenging it is not appropriate to have children of various ages in the one group. Please do not worry as this system is tried and tested and works very well.

Check the Notice Board for information regarding camp activities.

Children will have two breaks each day, and they will need to bring a packed lunch. Chewing gum is not permitted.

Children should bring 3 to 4 non-fizzy drinks to camp each day.

Children should wear a sun hat. Apply suncream prior to camp. Children will be reminded to reapply their suncream during the day.

If the weather is inclement, please ensure your child has appropriate **rainwear** as activities will run as scheduled.

Please ensure that your child wears **runners** to the camp each day.

Each evening lost property will be displayed in the hall. Please check that your child has all his/her belongings, as we are not responsible for items lost.

To avoid congestion, children will leave the hall each evening in their groups. The younger children (5-6 years) will remain in the hall and can be collected when the older children have left.

Photographs may be taken at the camp for promotional reasons.

If you need help, or have any queries during the week our Camp Manager will be only too delighted to help you.
